If the amounts to be paid or the payment dates change, The Conservative Party will notify you at least 10 working days in advance of your account being debited, or as otherwise agreed. If an error is made by The Conservative Party or your Bank or Building Society, you are guaranteed a full and immediate refund from your branch of the amount paid. Political Party Elections and Referendums Act 2000. Under the Political Party Elections and Referendums Act 2000 (PPERA) you must be on the electoral register in the UK excluding the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man in order to make a donation of more than £500. If you donate more than £2,230 to the Party, we are obliged under the PPERA to report such a donation to the Electoral Commission, who will publish the fact that you have made a donation over £2,230.
